

Dear Jacquie,

I am writing to let you know how Bio Magic has been successful in the toilet sanitization of 27 coaches that are operated through out Western Australia.

I work for Goldrush Tours we are based in Kalgoorlie, Western Australia. I first heard about Bio Magic from my parents who own a Motorhome old coach, they heard about Bio Magic on the road, as you would well know, the best grapevine is the one that travels around Australia.

Being owners of a Merc motorhome (coach) also, and members of CMCA I went about hunting how Goldrush Tours could use this 100% environmentally toilet system in our coaches.

The tourism industry is one of many skeptics, so you can imagine the talking I had to do to the manager. But being very persuasive I had the backing of our Workshop Manager also owns a Civilian motorhome.

So now 7months down the track, word has got out about Goldrush Tours using this great stuff in their coach toilets.

The system we run is the Heavy Duty BioMagic. Which we water down 5 litres water to one litre Bio Magic.

When we first started using Bio Magic we gave our septic tanks a good dose of 1 litre.

All our coaches run different size holding tanks, cassette toilets.

We have one coach that does desert runs to the Northern Territory border. It's great to know when we need to dump the toilet that we can get rid of the system and not hurt the environment at all.

The drivers are amazed also at how well BioMagic works, with getting rid of the chemical smell from the usual Blue chemical that most coaches and travelers use.

Our septic tanks that used to smell, now are basically odorless, and the grass and trees are doing wonderfully with the grey water that is produced by Bio Magic, being watered at least 4 times a day.

We also have coaches that travel the South West of Western Australia; these drivers are also putting the word out to other operators. With whom I have now had words with and am also changing over to Bio Magic. So the tourism industry and operators are getting in on the environmentally friendly Bio Magic.

I would like to let all operators know change over to Bio Magic, not only is helping the environment, but also saving money in the process.

With the coaches that we have, some are 100litre holding tanks so we use 30 – 50 ml of Bio Magic depending on the water volume we put into the coach.

Others have 20 litre cassette toilets so 20ml of Bio Magic goes in each time we load the toilets with 20 litres of water.

One of our coaches is fully carpeted and an amount of Blue toilet chemical got spilt onto the steps of the toilet and the coach smelt really bad. So we made up a spray bottle and sprayed some Bio Magic onto the carpet and carefully with a nail brush scrubbed the carpet. We did this twice and now the coach does not smell like a toilet.

So again I thank Bio Magic and CMCA for their confidence to give travelers and coach operators something great to use on one of the most important places whilst traveling.
