Geoff, you delivered some BioMagic to our place in Capalaba a couple of weeks back. Thank you.

I have probably been a little liberal with my use, but only to set up the septic tank on the property and the general house sump. Yet to get it into the grease trap, as it is hard to get to under the house, at my age and flexibility, so have to talk my son in law into going there when he comes home from work daily.

Further I am almost ecstatic as far as use in the motorhome's grey and black tanks. The grey tank, I used 160ml for 160litre tank, put it all in at 1/3 full. Left that overnight and filled the tank in use over the next two days, and then emptied it. The discharge came out very oxygenated and no smell. A bit of "sediment" came out near the end of the draining, and I assume this is what was "lining" the tank previously. As for the black water tank, as we are not travelling at the moment, it is probably not "sloshing" around to be it's most effective, but we'll get around to that soon, but we have already noticed the difference with the discharge at emptying and no smell.

What a brilliant product - you've won me.

Just a question, what about pouring some into the dam? 160,000 gallons approx. Would it help the decomposition of leaf litter? Would it kill the fish (mainly minnows and yabbies)? Just a thought
