## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### IMPORTANT:

Follow the below instructions if using in a new system or continuing use of BioMagic. If changing your portable system from another product, please follow instruction on the next page.

### Portable Toilets & Small Waste Tanks

Add 15mL to the waste tank with 1 inch of water covering the bottom, then shake the tank to mix in. Use fresh water in the flush tank. Ensure water covers all ridges or divisions in the bottom of the waste tank.



### Holding / Black / Large Waste Tanks

Add 25mL of BioMagic per person per week. Initially add water to cover the bottom of the tank by 1-2 inches (25mL per 40-50L)

### Grey Water Tanks

Add 10mL per 50L of grey water. To clean the tank add 10mL per 40L and fill to the top and soak for 8hrs, go for a drive, then drain.

### NOTE

If camped and not travelling around, gently shake the waste tank on a regular basis to ensure the waste is underwater as there is no treatment in the air if waste is above the liquid line.

Ensure you remove all residue from previous cleaning products before using BioMagic.

**DO NOT USE** any chemical based cleaners in or on the toilet as it will affect the toilet surface and operation of the toilet



## CHANGING TO BIOMAGIC PRODUCTS?

If you are changing from another product to BioMagic, Follow the instructions below to set up BioMagic in your system for first use

1. Empty the cassette or bottom tank of toilet completely and then rinse completely twice with fresh water.
2. Stand the unit on it's end & point the tube skywards. Close the slide.
3. Add a good squirt of dishwashing liquid and 100mL of BioMagic.
4. Fill the tank full with water and close the cap tightly. Let soak for at least 24 hours
5. Empty half of the water, shake the tank/cassette, then empty out and rinse with fresh water.
6. Wearing a glove, dry the slide & all seals with a paper towel, put a small amount of olive oil or cooking oil on the slide & rubber seals and rub in. Wipe off the excess.
7. Your Toilet is now ready to use

## PORTABLE TOILET TIPS

### HELPFUL TIPS TO GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR PORTABLE TOILET SYSTEM

#### Flush Tanks:

These tanks are best filled with fresh water, just add a few drops of dishwashing soap to help maintain a fresh odour and assist in the flushing process. Keeping your flush tank (freshwater tank) in good condition is easy, simply ensure it is completely emptied and cleaned after a trip and then refill with fresh water before you head on your next trip.

#### Toilet Bowls

Usually made of plastic, or porcelain in newer motorhomes and caravans. It's recommended that you do not use solvent based cleaning products as this can damage the surfaces and cause permanent yellowing, peeling laminate, or weakening the plastic surface over time. Instead, use gentler solutions like mild soap and water to clean and disinfect your toilet bowl without causing damage.

#### Slide and Valve Seals:

The most used part of a portable toilet system, so its important you look after your seals to avoid leaks and failed seals. To service a seal, inspect and ensure they are clean and dry. Then using olive oil or cooking oil, with a glove, rub the oil over the seals. This keeps the rubber from drying out and cracking or perishing when you need it the most.

**NEVER** scrub a seal or use harsh or abrasive chemical products to clean a seal as this will speed up damage and cause issues with the operation of the slide and all parts involved in the smooth operation of your portable toilet system
